Dr Matthew Samuel is a Consultant Psychiatrist at Hollywood Medical Centre, Nedlands, and member of Ethics Committee at Hollywood Private Hospital, Perth. He is also the Clinical Director of the West Australian Centre for Trauma Treatment and Research Centre, Nedlands.

Dr Samuel is a Senior Clinical Lecturer at the University of Western Australia, a Clinical Associate Professor at the University of Notre Dame, Fremantle, and is also the Foundation Board Member for the PTSD WA Research Foundation.

He specialises in psychiatry for the elderly, post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), and acute mental health illnesses, including schizophrenia, psychosis and severe depression.

Dr Samuel obtained his MBBS from the University of Kerala, India, in 1996 before becoming a Fellow of the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Psychiatrists (FRANZCP) in 2007. He has further completed a Certificate in Old Age Psychiatry at the Faculty of Psychiatry of Old Age (FPOA), RANZCP, and a Diploma in Psychological Medicine from the National Institute of Mental Health and Neuroscience.

He served as the Chair of the Psychiatry Advisory Committee and Deputy Chair of Medical Advisory Committee at Hollywood Private Hospital between 2014 and 2020. Dr Samuel was also the past Secretary and Chair of Faculty of Psychiatry Old Age of the RANZCP WA branch.

With extensive academic experience, Dr Samuel is as an accredited trainee supervisor for the RANZCP, and an examiner for the Objective Structured Clinical Exam (OSCE). He has also written papers for the Committee for Examinations, RANZCP, and has published several, notable academic articles on mental health issues.
